WHAT IS A MEDICAL ASSISTANT?

Medical assistants are a crucial part of any healthcare team. They are equipped to provide both direct patient care and administrative assistance to ensure that patients have a positive experience. Medical assistants work closely with doctors, nurses, and other medical staff within the facility to provide seamless care.

Medical assistants' training will prepare them to perform patient care procedures such as blood draws, EKGs, specimen collection, visual acuity tests, injections, and more. Incorporated into the curriculum of UCI's online medical assisting training program are hands-on clinical days at the <u>UCI campus</u> in Irwin, Pennsylvania.

Because UCI Online medical assistants are also trained in administrative tasks, they help the medical facility run smoothly behind the scenes. Their versatile skillset in charting, processing insurance, software usage, and other administrative tasks make them valuable to hospitals, family medicine practices, outpatient clinics, laboratories, and other facilities.



THE UCI ACADEMIC PROCESS

They can then confidently take industry-specific National Healthcareer Association certifications* and embark on their medical careers.



18-MONTH DEGREE PROGRAM

The United Career Institute Clinical Medical Assistant program equips students with the knowledge, skills, training, experience, and specialized associate degree they need for a successful medical assisting career in just 18 months.

Our degree program offers a convenient online format for students to balance their family, work, and academic goals. The virtual instruction is paired with weekend clinicals to gain hands-on experience. This unique combination of online and clinical training provides students with essential knowledge, direct patient care skills, proficiency in administrative tasks, and certification* preparation. Earning industry-specific certifications, such as those from the NHA, can provide graduates' resumes with an added bonus by showcasing that they have met nationally recognized standards of skill and competency.





MEDICAL ASSISTING TO PRACTICAL NURSING

The United Career Institute Clinical Medical Assistant to Practical Nursing Pathway option allows students to complete the medical assisting training program to gain hands-on medical skills, then graduate and begin working. Then, if they choose to further their education, they can attend UCI's Practical Nursing program.

Starting a career as a medical assistant can be beneficial for potential nursing students because it allows them to become accustomed to working in the healthcare field and gain real-world experience before entering intensified nursing training. Additionally, graduates of a UCI medical training program are eligible for a Nursing Pathway Grant.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What does a medical assistant do?

A: Medical assistants are qualified to perform direct patient care duties such as phlebotomy, taking vitals, administering injections, and other tasks. Additionally, they are trained in administrative responsibilities which include managing electronic health records, processing insurance claims, utilizing software, and more.

Q: How to get a medical assistant certification?

A: As a student in either the United Career Institute Clinical Medical Assistant degree or Medical Assisting diploma programs, you will prepare to sit for the NHA Certified Clinical Medical Assistant certification* exam as part of your curriculum.

Q: How long is a medical assistant degree program?

A: The Clinical Medical Assistant training program at UCI is 18 months, allowing students to complete their training and begin their medical assisting careers in two years or less.
