WHAT IS MEDICAL CODING?

Medical coders play a crucial role in the healthcare team, acting as liaisons between healthcare providers, patients, and insurance companies. The UCI Online Medical Coding program prepares aspiring medical coders with the essential skills to accurately handle electronic healthcare records, billing, and insurance claims.

As per the <u>American Association of Professional Coders</u> (<u>AAPC</u>), medical coders convert patient visit documentation into standardized codes that specify a patient's diagnosis, medical treatments, services, or supplies. Medical coders streamline communication between patients and healthcare providers by using standardized <u>classification systems</u> like CPT®, ICD-10-CM, and HCPCS Level II. These classifications play a vital role in ensuring precise patient records and facilitating payments to healthcare providers.






CORE VALUES & PURPOSE

The <u>American Association of Professional Coders (AAPC)</u> is the largest training and credentialing organization for medical coders, billers, auditors, and similar healthcare professionals. In the three decades since its establishment in 1988, the AAPC has conferred thousands of industry professionals with valuable certifications.

The significance of obtaining an AAPC certification cannot be emphasized enough. It demonstrates to employers that you have achieved nationally recognized competency standards and have received comprehensive training in medical coding practice.







THE AAPC CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL CODER-APPRENTICE EXAM

Medical coding is a career path that requires excellent attention to detail and in-depth skills training. Because of the vast knowledge a medical coder must possess, their education does not end upon graduation.

UCI Online medical coding students will be prepared to sit for the <u>AAPC Certified Professional Coder-Apprentice</u>* exam. The cost of two attempts to sit for the exam is included in the program tuition as a benefit of UCI Online.

Upon passing the exam, you will earn the CPC-A credential. The "-A" will remain attached until further education requirements through AAPC are completed.

Hands-On Training and Externship Experience

Students at United Career Institute can acquire essential skills through online lectures led by instructors who emphasize hands-on skill training. Additionally, they will complete an externship experience, where they will gain experience in a real-world setting. By the conclusion of the medical coding training program, students will be prepared to sit for the AAPC Certified Professional Coder-Apprentice (CPC-A)* exam.

Accelerated Training

As a result of our direct admission program, students will complete their training in only 18 months. <u>Accelerated training</u> allows students to learn the necessary skills, prepare to sit for the CPC-A* exam, and enter the workforce quickly, rather than spending 4-6 years at a traditional school.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How to get a medical coding certification?

A: Preparation for the American Association of Professional Coders (AAPC) Certified Professional Coder-Apprentice* exam is incorporated directly into UCI's Medical Coding program curriculum. As an added benefit of the program, two attempts to sit for the exam is included in the program's tuition cost.

Q: How long is schooling for medical coding?

A: The length of time spent in school to become a medical coder varies based on the type of program. According to <u>HealthJob</u>, a medical coding training program can typically take anywhere from six months to four years, depending on whether the program awards a certificate, associate degree, or bachelor's degree.

Q: Is medical coding a good career?

A: Medical coders possess a specific skill set that makes them valuable and respected healthcare team members. They are essential to the smooth operations of a medical facility.

Q: Where do medical coders work?

A: Because of their unique skills, medical coders have opportunities in various disciplines, including hospitals, private medical practices, insurance companies, government agencies, law firms, and more.

Q: What do medical coders do?

A: In short, medical coders act as the liaison between physicians, their patients, and insurance companies. They utilize a standardized labeling system to identify and organize treatment plans, diagnoses, and doctor-patient interactions to ensure accuracy in billing and electronic health records.
